Josh still lives in Huntsville, AL having returned from an assignment in Germany where he spent most of this past year. Rebecca lives in Fayetteville, NC. Patrick and Laura with their one daughter, Penelope Joy who is also 4 years old, still live in Franklin. We get to see Penelope the most which is a joy for us. She now comes to our house to POP-set me two days each week so Laura can work more. Andrew & Justine with Hayden, twins Sawyer & Marlana, and Ruthie (ages 12, 4, 4 and 2) live in Columbia, TN which is 30 minutes south of us. Add an active dog or two – need I say more?!!
